Fairplex Park is located at Fairplex in Pomona, home of the annual L.A. County Fair, freeway close to the 57, 10 and 210. The five-eighths mile track is nestled within the beautiful backdrop of the San Gabriel Mountains and the distinctive cupolas from Barretts Equine Limited. Fairplex Park became the first track in Southern California to offer pari-mutuel wagering when it was legalized in California in 1933. The historic Fair racing meet is celebrating its 73rd anniversary.
